




Deck Plan




SUNDECK



UPPER DECK




MAIN DECK

Salvage and Security Equipment

The Alya is a modern catamaran built in Guayaquil in 2017. It was designed according ecological parameters that reduce the environmental impact in the Galapagos Islands.



- 35 life jackets
- 4 lifebuoys 9mm
- Flare gun, smoke signals
- SOS flashlights signals and other types of visual signals.
- 2 survival rafts, 25 passengers each.
- Fire extinguishers 10 lb and 2lb.
- Fire hoses 15m.
- Fire detectors and complete fire protection system.
